



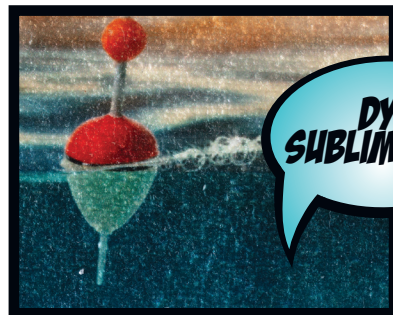

SHARK MONTH DYE SUBLIMATION / PT49

MATERIALS USED: Milmaki Ink and S10 tack paper

PROCESSES USED: 60 seconds at 390°F, medium pressure

ADDITIONAL NOTES: Best applied to white or light-color polyester fabrics that can withstand high temperatures without scorching.



DESIGN INTENT:

A very playful commemoration of Shark Month at a local aquarium. Full sublimation allows for a dramatic photo-real logo.
